The minutes of the January meeting were read and approved.

Joining Dig Safe is ongoing. Jeff is sending an email to them asking how they want the map and location sent to them.

Gilford Well came and blew out the lines. There were 2 blow offs that failed. The failed blow offs were the one at end of Bridge Street and the one at the south end of the system. They will have to be dug up next spring and fixed. Jeff has not had time to talk with Mike Wright about an estimate to do the digging. Allan will call Aaron Daisey or Dave LaCasse to see if they are interested in doing the plumbing on the shut offs next spring. Jane put \$3737.00 in the Equipment Repairs category the budget to cover this repair.

Jane submitted the MS60-A for the audit.

Bill has done the DES Land Conservation Grant Program Annual Inspection Report and given it to Jane to send it and a copy to file.

The annual meeting will be 4/5/22. The budget hearing will be 3/1/22. Both at the pump house.

There has been another problem with the choloinator. Gilford Well rebuilt the top part from our spare chlorinator and installed it on the working one. He has taken the old back to see what the problem was.


Another letter was received from one customer. He felt that we did not answer his previous questions and asked more questions. Jane sent out this letter after the commissioners reviewed it.
