The minutes of the December meeting were read and approved.

Gilford Well took an iron and manganese test when they did the December testing. This will tell us if it is time to flush the 3 big tanks. The tests came back negative so that the tanks do not have to be rebedded at this time.

Jane told two customers on the December bills that have a large bill that if the bill is not paid up to date by 5/1/21 we will shut the water off.

Allan will give one copy to the State garage in town. It was decided that the Town does not need a map as there is just a short distance of the water line on town roads. Jeff Winagle will ask Eversource if they need a copy of the map. He will also ask them more about Dig Safe. He thinks there will be a fee to get our map information on the Dig Safe website.

2 customers have removed the meter readers to do improvements to their houses and lost the meters. It was decided we would charge \$25.00 for a replacement meter. 1 meter has been replaced. The other one will wait until renovations are done.

Jane has put all the shut off gps readings and locations in an excel spreadsheet. Jane sent it to Bill to see if he has any corrections or additions. It contains all shut offs on the system. She has not checked to see if he had any comments yet.

We received the annual dues bill of \$115.00 from Granite State Rural Water. It was voted to pay the bill and give them a \$25.00 donation.

The 2021 Budget hearing will be 3/2/21. The Annual Meeting will be 4/6/21. Both are on our regular meeting nights.
