Those present: Allan Hebb, Commissioner, Jane Hebb, Acting Clerk, Treasurer, David Smith and William McKee

The minutes of the September meeting were read and approved.

Jane needs to contact the Town administrative assistant to see if the district budget should be included in the town report. She will also ask about who should be auditing the accounts, Town auditor, or our own auditor.

Joining Dig Safe is ongoing. Someone needs to take this over. Jeff Winagle was doing it.

Allan needs to call Mike Wright to try to schedule at time this fall to dig up the blow offs. He said he was too busy to set a date right now. He is willing to do the connection of the new blow offs instead of having Lance Colby install the new blow offs. There were 2 blow offs that failed, the one at end of Bridge Street and the one at the south end of the system.

Jeff Hebb did the annual brush hogging when he has time.

David Smith has agreed to be a Commissioner until the next annual meeting.

Jane submitted the MS 434 due September 1.

Bill let the person from Cat in to do the annual maintenance on the generator. He sent an estimate of \$3541.96 to repair work to do cooling system repairs. It was voted to have it done on this years budget. Jane will notify Milton Cat. It was voted that we would purchase our own new battery, as we did before. Allan will do that. Jane was asked to make sure that none of these repairs are covered under out 5 year maintenance contract.

At the Granite State Rural Water annual meeting in September our water was again voted to be the best in the state. No one was interested in going to Washington DC to accept the award. We received a nice plaque. 2017 was the last time we were voted to have the best water in the state.

Bill and Allan are checking to see if the REACTR System needs to be refiltered. It was last done 3/18. Gilford Well did a lead and manganese test this month. This will tell us if the tanks need to be refiltered. If so this should be included in the 2023 budget.

The cemetery is going to put excess dirt on the bank that borders our land and cut some brush.

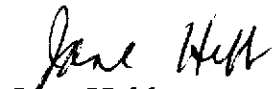
Allan is working on getting more meters. We are running low.
